Victims and other community members have the right to know about the status of individuals placed in our county jail.

What will WI VINE do for me?

Although WI VINE was created with victim's safety in mind, it is available to anyone who wants to receive custody information about an offender in a county jail.

Ways to use WI VINE:

You can call or log on to WI VINE anytime to check the custody status of an offender. You can also register with WI VINE to receive automated notifications about changes to an offender's custody's status. These notifications can be sent to you by phone and/or e-mail, depending on how you complete your registration.
